

## "BY-LAWS"

The By-Laws of the Route 66 Cruisers Car Club shall always be subject to the Constitution and Laws of the State of Oklahoma

**OFFICERS**: No member shall serve for more than two (2) consecutive terms, on year each and shall be ineligible for re-election to the office until one year has elapsed.

There shall be President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer.

**COMMITTEES:** If now volunteers, shall be appointed by the President

**PRESIDENT:** Shall preside over ALL meetings of the Route 66 Cruisers. His vote will ONLY be used to break any ties. He shall be listed on the Club bank account.

VICE-PRESIDENT: Shall sit in for the President in the event he is unable to preside at the meeting and assist the President in any decisions necessary for the club operation.

**SECERATRY:** Shall keep a record of the Club meetings and provide a report of such at each meeting.

TREASURER: Shall receive and safely keep all Club funds and deposit to the Club bank account. All expenses of the Club will be disbursed by checks written by the treasurer from that account. An audit shall be conducted prior to change in the office of Treasurer.

In 2009 we voted to extend the time the current Treasurer could serve.

**DUES:** For each member (family membership) dues are assessed for the calendar year. The fiscal year shall begin on the first meeting of the year and be valid until the last day of the year. Current dues amount (family membership) is \$15.00 per fiscal year.

In May 2014, we voted to change the membership to \$15 for an individual and \$20 for a family.

A family membership consists of both spouses and children still living at home.

**VOTING:** Only members in good standing may vote or hold office.

**ELECTIONS**: Shall be conducted at the December regular meeting or a special meeting may be called.

**CLUB PURPOSE**: To promote fellowship and the Classic Car movement, to participate as a group in all Classic Car events.

These By-Laws may be amended subject to two-thirds majority of the general membership at a regularly scheduled meeting by written ballot and only after amendments are decided the vote will be called at the next regularly scheduled meeting.
